ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS Water System Improvements for the City of Baldwin, Georgia

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Baldwin, Georgia (OWNER), for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and any other miscellaneous items necessary for the construction of Water System Improvements in Baldwin, Georgia.

Bids will be received at City of Baldwin 130 Airport Road Baldwin, GA until 2:00 p.m. on July 28, 2016. Any bid received after said time and date of bid opening will not be considered by OWNER. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at this time and location. All bids will be evaluated by OWNER and the project will be awarded, if it is awarded, within sixty (60) days of the bid opening. If a bidder is not selected within sixty (60) days of the bid opening, any bidder that is determined by the OWNER to be unlikely of being selected for contract award shall be released from their bid.

The award of this bid proposal, if awarded, shall be based on several criteria, including prices bid, experience in the work proposed, and references. Refer to Article 14 of Section 00100 for criteria and award method.

The Project consists of, but is not limited to the following major elements for two (2) contracts:

CONTRACT NO. 1:

Construction of one (1) elevated water storage tank, demolition of one (1) existing water storage tank, construction of one (1) retaining wall structure, installation of approximately 85 L.F. of 8-inch DIP, 20 L.F. of 6-inch DIP, 2 each 6-inch gate valves and related appurtenances.

CONTRACT NO. 2:

Construction of one(1) each booster pumping station, 4 each 6-inch pressure reducing valves and manholes, installation of approximately 450 L.F. of 12-inch DIP on an existing bridge, approximately 3,000 L.F. of 10-inch DR 18 C900 PVC waterline and related appurtenances.

Contracts No. 1 and No. 2 are two separate contracts, but shall be bid and constructed simultaneously.

<u>CONTRACT NO. 1:</u> Time of completion for all work associated with Contract No. 2 shall be three hundred sixty (360) consecutive calendar days from the date of a written "Notice to Proceed" from OWNER.

<u>CONTRACT NO. 2</u>: Time of completion for all work associated with Contract No. 2 shall be three hundred sixty (360) consecutive calendar days from the date of a written "Notice to Proceed" from OWNER.

OWNER requires a bid bond* or a certified cashier's check in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid to be enclosed with the bid at the time of bid opening. Cashier's check will be made payable to City of Baldwin.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish OWNER with Insurance, Workman's Compensation Insurance, and Performance and Payment Bonds* in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) of the total bid.

Each bid must be submitted in a SEALED ENVELOPE, addressed to the OWNER. Each sealed envelope containing a Bid must be plainly marked on the outside as, "Water System Improvements – Contract No. ____ for the City of Baldwin, Georgia" and be labeled with the BIDDER'S State of Georgia Utility Contractor License Number. If bid is forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the Bid must be enclosed in a separate mailing envelope to the attention of the OWNER at the address previously given.

All Bids must be made out on the bid form of the type bound in the Contract Documents, in accordance with the instructions in the Information for Bidders. No interlineation, additions, or deletions shall be made in the proposal form by the BIDDER.

Any and all Bids received without the aforementioned qualification criteria enclosed, will be returned to the BIDDER.

CONTRACTORS and SUBCONTRACTORS bidding on this Project will be required to comply with all Federal, State, and local laws.

OWNER reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all Bids, to evaluate Bids, and to accept any Bid which in its opinion may be in the best interest of the OWNER. No Bid will be rejected without just cause.

Successful Bidder will be required to perform WORK as the Prime Contractor. WORK performed by Prime Contractor shall be at a minimum 30% of the contract value.

No BIDDER may withdraw his bid within the time limit specified in the Instruction to Bidders (Section 00100).

The City of Baldwin has acquired all necessary permits in connection with this project except for Georgia EPD, Land Disturbance, Georgia Department of Transportation, and Norfolk Southern Railroad. The City of Baldwin is in the process of acquiring one (1) easement in connection with this project and anticipates that this easements and all permits will be acquired within 60 days of the date of receiving bids.

* Surety companies executing Bonds must appear on the Treasury Department's most current list (Circular 570 as amended) and be authorized to transact business in the State of Georgia. For Performance Bonds less than \$300,000 an irrevocable Letter of Credit from a bank as defined in O.C.G.A. Code Section 7-1-4 may be submitted in lieu of a bond. In lieu of a Payment Bond, a Cashier's Check, Certified Check, or Cash may be submitted in an amount not less than the total amount payable by the terms of the CONTRACT.
