The City of Hiawassee is the sole provider of drinking water in Towns County. The City's Water Plant is located on Lake Chatuge. The Water Treatment Facility utilizes a floating water intake to pump up to 2.25 Million Gallons per Day. The existing floating intake has been in service for over 20 years and has reached its useful Life. A new floating water intake is planned to be installed in June of 2014.

The project was funded by City Funds and a GEFA Loan. Components of the facility include a floating dock constructed of galvanized steel and two raw water pumps each capable of pumping 2.0 MGD. In addition an air burst system will be in place to clean the intake screens. A hoist system will be provided to allow removal of the pumps and suction intakes if service is needed.

The project will result in a more reliable water intake than the previous system. Because the City of Hiawassee is the sole provider of drinking water in Towns County this project was a high priority for the City.
